


Guide on Using Your Pin



The above screenshot is the one the student see when viewing their essential skills cluster. If they would like to get a particular section immediately approved by his/her mentor, they would hand the device over to the mentor and indicate which section needs to be assessed. The mentor will select the “sign as mentor button”.



This screen shall then appear where the mentor will select their name and enter their “pin” that they made when creating their account, if the mentor enters the correct pin they will gain access to mentor rights and will be able to sign off the section. If the mentor enters the incorrect pin the portfolio will direct back to the students dashboard/homepage.

If the mentor gains access this is the page that will appear, here the mentor has the right to either pass or fail each section and save their marks using the “save marks” button at the top

Once the mentor has saved their feedback it is important that they select the log off icon to sign out of their account.
